

Laundering and Care

- 1. Remove all panels and/or any metal components prior to cleaning.
- This brace can be hand washed in cold or lukewarm water with mild soap or detergent and air dried
- 3. Do not use any substance containing Chlorine



- 1. Place the brace around your hip.
- Pull and wrap the sides around the right side overlapping the left with velcro closure.
- 3. Pull the webbing straps outward.
- Pass the right strap through the D-ring of the left side and secure.
- Readjust the length with the buckle of the left side if necessary and ensure that the brace fit is snug and does not cause any discomfort.
