MANUFACTURED BY

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1. Placement

Slide affected hand through wrist band and into thumb orthosis. Make sure thumb and thumb strap at the front of the thumb splint are aligned.

2. Secure thumb strap

Feed the thumb strap through the D-ring and secure.

3. Secure wrist strap

Feed the wrist strap though the D-ring and secure.

4. Shape sewn-in metal stay

Press the D-shaped sewn pattern with unaffected hand to mold the inner metal stay for contoured fit

5. Figure 8 strapping

Pull & wrap elastic strap by figure-8 pattern as shown and secure.

6. Fit Adjustment

Readjust the strap to ensure firm support without impairing circulation.
