

Laundering and Care

- 1. Remove all plastic and/or any metal components prior to cleaning.
- This brace can be hand washed in cold or lukewarm water with mild soap or detergent and air dried
- 3. Do not use any substance containing Chlorine

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

Application Instruction



1. Placement and wrap closure

The brace is put on, with the center of the hinges (Fig. 1) to the joint line (both medial & lateral). Then, wrap around with the velcro closure.(Fig. 2)



Starting with the upper strap, feed straps through the D-rings and secure. (fig 3, 4) Fit should be snug but not too tight as to restrict circulation.
